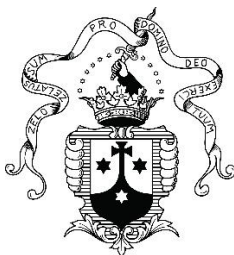

CONCERNING THE PLENARY INDULGENCE ON THE SOLEMN
COMMEMORATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY OF MOUNT CARMEL

The Prior General of the Order of Discalced Friars of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel humbly requests that the faithful, having made sacramental Confession and received Holy Communion, and having recited, according to the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff, the *Our Father* and the *Hail Mary*, or any other prayer according to their devotion, on the day of the solemn Commemoration of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel, or, with the consent of the Ordinary, on the Sunday immediately preceding or following, may obtain a Plenary Indulgence, to be gained once only, provided that they have devoutly visited any church or a public oratory of the First, Second, or Third Regular Order of the Discalced Friars of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel, and there have recited the *Our Father* and the *Creed*.

**APOSTOLIC PENITENTIARY
DECREE
(1440/'68/R)**

CONCERNING THE PLENARY INDULGENCE OF 2 AUGUST

The Prior General of the Order of Discalced Friars of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Mount Carmel humbly requests that the members of the First, Second, and Third Regular Orders of the said Order, having made sacramental Confession and received Holy Communion, and having recited, according to the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff, the *Our Father* and the *Hail Mary*, or any other prayer according to their devotion, may obtain, once only, a Plenary Indulgence on the day of 2 August, or, with the consent of the Ordinary, on the Sunday immediately preceding or following, provided that they have devoutly visited any church or a public oratory of the same Order and there have recited the *Our Father* and the *Creed*.
